Emergency Action Plan for Home Games and Training Sessions

Each team has it's own designated first aider(s) who will deal with any medical situations.

First Aid Equipment

A first aid kit is always in the possession of the team.

A defibrillator is located at the Sports Hall reception.

Action Plan for Emergency Services

Each team will follow these simple steps and the person in charge of the medical situation will direct others to do the following:

- 1) First Aider(s) Must remain with injured person at all times.
- 2) Emergency Caller An individual will be directed to make the call to the emergency services. The first aider will pass on the information that you need to make the call handler aware of. This person must also telephone Longfield on the above number, to inform them there is a medical situation and an Ambulance is en route. Once the two aforementioned calls have been made this individual must also contact the parents/carers of the injured person to make them aware of the situation.
- 3) Runner This person will be responsible for getting anything that the first aider requires to deal with the situation.
- 4) Crowd Assistant This individual is responsible for ensuring that all non-involved parties are away from the situation and maintaining dignity for the injured person whilst supporting any other party who may become upset about the situation.
- 5) Runner 2 Is to head to Longfield Road to meet the Ambulance Crew on their arrival and direct them to the location of the injured person.

The named First Aiders for each team will ensure the immediate care and attention is given to your child, and your child will be cared for by them until the emergency services arrive to take over. You will be contacted once the emergency services have been phoned for.
